Dear Parents,

We have had a great week in school, and we hope you have had a good week too.

Thank you so much to all our parents and children who supported CAFOD Family Fast Day today by donating money and allowing your children to come to school wearing something bright. A CAFOD strap line is: A better, brighter world takes all of us. Children in Years 3 – 6 walked to church to join the parish mass and behaved impeccably and reverently; they were all a credit to you. It really was a beautiful mass. Readers were clear and confident. Hymns were joyful, especially our final hymn which was Rise and Shine. Once again we see the impact of working in partnership: Miss Caswell and Mrs Fox rehearsed hymns with KS2, Mrs O'Reilly planned the mass with Kieran and rehearsed readers and parents helped supervise children walk to church. We are definitely at our best when parish, home and school work together. Our younger children enjoyed walking laps of the playground to show solidarity with their global brothers and sisters.

Since joining St Thomas Catholic Academies Trust we have become a totally 'cashless' school. This includes charitable donations which now can only be made via ParentPay. Thank you for your generosity in donating £238 to last week's Macmillan coffee morning and £132 today for CAFOD. Donations are very much appreciated by the good causes they will reach. However, these are lower than when we accepted cash donations and children generally brought in £1 each. Both Macmillan and CAFOD will remain on ParentPay until the end of this half term should you wish to donate.

Children can receive an annual flu vaccination in school on 17th October. Please do remember to register if this is something you would like your child to receive (more information in this newsletter).

I have been very impressed with numerous young people this week. Our new sports coach, Mr Holder, is extremely well organised and is delivering very high standard PE lessons which children are engaging well with. We have also welcomed some past pupils this week. Thea Dmaro has supported our EYFS team brilliantly and we look forward to her continuing to work with us on Mondays. On Wednesday afternoon, we enjoyed some Year 12 students from St Bernard's volunteering. They certainly made a positive impression and we look forward to the regular help they have offered.

Reception Supplementary Forms can be obtained from the school website or the school office.
