Dear Parents

On Thursday morning, we had the absolute delight of the Year 6 Variety Show, and what a show it was! Each and every act was thoroughly rehearsed and the children absolutely shone; the group of presenters pulled the whole show together wonderfully with their enthusiasm and sense of humour. We saw acts that we had never seen before, and many dancers and singers that kept the audience entertained for over an hour. What a talented bunch we have in Year 6!

KS2 children particularly enjoyed dice stacking by Aiden and watching Jed speedily solve his Rubix cube. Both acts drew spontaneous cheers from the audience which followed anticipation and suspense. We hold this performance annually, just prior to 11+ exam results being released, to remind everyone in Year 6 they are just as God intended them to be... fantastic young people who will all be successful following a myriad of different next steps after Holy Family.

Today, our Faith Ambassadors represented us brilliantly at the annual Diocesan School's Mass. They travelled to Dunstable with pupils from St Anthony's and St Ethelbert's, schools which belong to our St Thomas family of schools. Every school in the diocese was represented and addressed by Bishop David Oakley, who shared God's blessing for the year ahead.

Our fifteen Faith Ambassadors have each been assigned a class for which they have the responsibility of delivering the weekly 'Wednesday Word'. The Wednesday Word is a Catholic outreach programme that provides resources that our faith Ambassadors are using to share the Sunday Gospel and lead children in a short reflection. Our young leaders started this ministry this week and they were very well received from Nursery to Year 6. Well done Faith Ambassadors.

Well done to all our Year 5/6 footballers who won their mid-week match; it was a great start to the season. Mr Holder particularly enjoyed this win as, until July 2024, he was a sports coach at Cippenham Primary School. Read more about the game in the newsletter.

The Department for Education issued updated attendance guidance for all schools which came into effect in August 2024. It is called 'Working Together to Improve School Attendance'. This brings significant changes to how we will monitor and address unauthorised absences. More detailed information about this will be shared with parents next week in a letter from Mrs Oakes (Attendance Officer) and Mrs Clarke (Attendance Champion).

This weekend our oldest children are expecting to receive their 11+ results; we wish all our Year 6 children the 11 + results they expect and hope for. Please hold them in your prayers in the next few weeks as they make choices about the secondary schools they aspire to attend.

A couple of reminders. If you have not done so already and you would like to order Christmas cards/gifts with your child's artwork on, please remember to return your child's artwork and

form to your child's class teacher on Monday (14th October). Also, please complete the flu consent form by 9am on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> October if you would like your child to receive the flu vaccine in school (Only 170 out of 450 pupils have consented so far). Winter uniform always looks smarter than summer uniform so you may wish to find your child's school tie for portrait photographs next Friday. Finally, Pantomime tickets (arranged by HFCS PTA) to see Dick Wittington at the Theatre Royal Windsor on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December go on sale tonight from 5pm. These tickets always sell out very quickly (usually within the hour/a few hours) so please do read the section at the end of this newsletter if you would like to buy tickets.
