Trackit Lights

GREEN – points & rewards

- Children can earn points, which are recorded on the Trackit lights table which is visible on IWB.
- Super Star awards give a child 10 points at once and are for something particularly outstanding. Such as displaying one of our Leaning Team characteristics.
- Certificates as children reach particular thresholds the will earn a certificate, which will be presented as part of the weekly KS assemblies.

 Eloise will be responsible for printing these but Sue will also have access.
- Class teachers can set their own whole class targets (in place of marble jars). eg. When 250 points are reached a class reward is achieved.

ORANGE- Step 1/minutes lost

- Child's name goes orange, type of behavior is recorded and a minute is lost from golden time.
- Child's weekly minutes can be viewed on individual behavior chart.
- For Golden time click on the graph icon, bottom left of class list. Select orange behaviours and pupil. Click down list to see how many minutes each child has lost.
- For End of term white behaviour certificates whole school results can be viewed through an admin account.

YELLOW - Step 2

- Take the Trackit lights off the whole screen/freeze/turn off so that the behaviour can be recorded privately, ensure the child receiving the step knows what type of behaviour is recorded and sanction given.
- Child's name will turn yellow. If you feel this is detrimental this can be removed with the X. This does not edit the behaviour recorded.
- Any Step 2 that the adult feels may need following up, could need referring back to or links to an ongoing issue should also be recorded on CPOMs, using the behaviour subheading.

Step 3 and above

• All Step 3s and above are recorded on CPOMs. A notification is sent to SLT through CPOMs so they are aware of who needs a detention.
