BOUNDARIES OF THE PARISH OF HOLY FAMILY LANGLEY, SLOUGH (2015 clarification)

These descriptions are intended to be read in conjunction with an Ordnance Survey 1:50,000 scale map, and a 1:25,000 one if possible, and possibly a large-scale street map. Beginning at the most northerly point and running clockwise

- Starting from the centre point of the Five Points roundabout, where the A412 Uxbridge Road (becoming Denham Rd) meets the A4007 coming in west from Uxbridge, and the minor road coming in south from Pinewood Studios. See Map A for points 1-4
- 2. By a short bee-line SE to the eastern edge of the row of buildings lying just south of the roundabout
- 3. From there, by a bee-line SSE to the midpoint of the farm lane / footpath running WNW between Love Green and Wood Lane, north-east of Heath Lodge. Then east along the lane to where it meets Swallow Lane.
- 4. From there, by a bee-line NE to the Y-junction where Bangors Road South meets Coppins Lane
- 5. Thence by a long bee-line NE, but slightly more southerly, to the point where the South Bucks / Hillingdon civic boundary, running along the River Colne, comes nearest to the northern tip of an ovalshaped pond (shown as a small lake NE of Palmers Moor Farm on the OS maps, but now mostly dry) (Grid ref 048825 - see Map B)
- 6. Running southwards and SSW for a long distance along the South Bucks and Slough civic borders with the London Borough of Hillingdon, until that boundary bends west at Junction 14 of the M25 motorway
- Then following, for a long way mainly NW, the civic boundary between the Slough Borough and, firstly, Spelthorne Borough, then the Royal Borough of Windsor & Maidenhead, to where it crosses the M4 motorway just west of Junction 5.
- From here, along the centreline of the M4 motorway SW, then curving west and NW, to the point where it is crossed by a private road through Upton Court Park, being a continuation of Lascelles Road. See Map C for points 8-10
- 9. NE along that private road and along Lascelles Road (east side only) to where it meets Sussex Place
- 10. NW along the centreline of Sussex Place to the centrepoint of the roundabout where Sussex Place / Wellington Street meets the A412 Uxbridge Road
- 11. NE and then ENE along the centreline of the A412 Uxbridge Road to our starting point.

Main villages and neighbourhoods included: Langley: Brands Hill, Colnbrook, Ditton Park, George Green, Huntsmoor Park, Iver, Langley Park, Love Green, Middle Green, Poyle, Richings Park, Shredding Green, Thorney

Excluded (for the avoidance of doubt): Cowley, Datchet, Horton, Iver Heath, Myrke, Pinewood Studios, Upton, Upton Lea, Uxbridge Moor, West Drayton, Yiewsley,

Possible future developments: None likely in this area which is already built-up or entirely within the Green Belt.
