

Holy Family Catholic School School Uniform Policy September 2023

<u>Boys – Winter Uniform</u> Dark grey trousers White school shirt School tie Royal blue jumper

<u>Boys – Summer Uniform</u> Dark grey trousers or shorts Royal blue school polo t-shirt Royal blue jumper <u>Footwear</u> Closed shoes or trainers Slippers or plimsolls for indoor use

<u>PE Kit</u> White t-shirt (plain or with school logo) Royal blue shorts Royal blue or plain navy tracksuit Trainers School PE bag

<u>Girls – Winter Uniform</u> Dark grey skirt or pinafore Dark grey trousers (Autumn half term until the end of Spring term) White school shirt School tie Royal blue cardigan or jumper

<u>Girls – Summer Uniform</u> Blue and white checked dress Royal blue cardigan or jumper Winter uniform (Year 6 only)

Summer uniform can be worn from Easter, and must be worn from May half term. Winter uniform can be worn from September, and must be worn from October half term. Slipper or plimsolls should be worn indoors. These should be closed shoes and not make a noise. Year 6 will be presented with a gold tie with blue stripes on their first day in Year 6. All school uniform and PE kit should be clearly labelled with your child's name.

Hair, jewellery and nail varnish

Hair should be kept back out of the eyes. No patterns should be shaved into boys' hair. Earrings should be small, plain studs; they should **not** be worn on days when there is PE or Swimming. No other jewellery should be worn.

A watch may be worn, although if it becomes a distraction for the child then they may be asked not to wear it.

Nail varnish must not be worn at school.

Guidance: Governors believe our uniform looks smarter when children arrive and leave school in black school shoes and when hair accessories, socks and tights are as below: Boys: Grey or black socks Girls: White, grey or black socks, grey or black tights. Girls' hair accessories should be simple in style and of the colours within our school uniform.
